CALL MEETING TO ORDER

- a. The meeting was called to order at 5:25 p.m.

1. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

- a. A quorum of members was not present. The minutes will be voted on at the next Harbor Committee meeting.

2. REVIEW MARINE AND STORAGE FEES

- a. Marine and storage fees were discussed at length. Mooring fees have not increased in four (4) years.
- b. The Committee recommended \$100 be set as the resident's base mooring fee plus a \$1 per foot. Multi-hulls will not be treated differently. Rental moorings fees will be \$175.
- c. The Harbor Budget will be presented to the Select Board on Monday evening. Ms. Leonard will explain to the Board a vote could not be taken on the proposed fee schedule because a quorum was not present at the Harbor Committee meeting.
- d. 'Multiple mooring holders' will be stricken from the fee schedule.

3. OTHER BUSINESS

- a. Policy changes are done by the Harbormaster.
- b. It has been 28 years since Rockport Harbor was dredged. Dredging should be done on a 25 year cycle.
- c. Boulders in the mouth of the Goose River will be removed before the new floats are installed. Blasting is not anticipated.
- d. Marital moorings will be placed on the next agenda.

The next Harbor Committee meeting will be held on April 14th at 5:15 p.m. at the Rockport Town Office.
