



This year “architectural paint” products will be accepted by Environmental Projects Inc., in partnership with paintcare as a recycling service during the hours of operation on Household Hazardous Waste Day **ONLY**.

Products will be collected if in its original container with the original manufacturer’s printed label and a secured lid. A maximum limit of 5 gallons will be enforced.

Acceptable Products

Interior and exterior architectural paints:
Latex, acrylic, water-based, alkyd, oil based, enamel (including textured coatings)

Deck coatings, floor paints (including elastomeric)

Primers, sealers, undercoaters
Stains

Shellacs, lacquers, varnishes, urethanes (single component)

Waterproofing concrete/masonry/wood sealers and repellents (not tar or bitumen-based)

Metal coatings, rust preventatives
Field and lawn paints



How to Safely Transport Items

- ✓ All items brought to the collection must be in sealed containers.
- ✓ Tighten caps and lids, leaving materials in the original labeled container when possible.
- ✓ Pack containers in sturdy, upright boxes and pad with newspapers. Sort and pack separately: paints, pesticides, household cleaners.
- ✓ NEVER MIX CHEMICALS.
- ✓ Place materials in vehicle, preferably in the trunk. Prevent box from tipping over in the car.
- ✓ Go directly to the collection site. On arrival, please stay in your car!

NEVER SMOKE while handling Hazardous Materials.

Children should NEVER handle Hazardous Materials.

- ✓ Degreasers, Disinfectants
- ✓ Cleaners (oven, ammonia-based), Drain Openers, Spot Removers.
- ✓ Flea Products
- ✓ Nail Polish Remove
- ✓ Hobby Supplies, Artist Supplies
- ✓ Aerosol Cans (No Empty Containers)

GARAGE:

- ✓ Oil/Alkyd – Based Paints
- ✓ Stains, Thinners, Paint Strippers
- ✓ Solvents (e.g. Acetone), Varnishes, Lacquers
- ✓ Adhesives, Rubber Cement
- ✓ Antifreeze
- ✓ Wood Preservatives
- ✓ Waste Fuels, (Kerosene, Gasoline and Diesel)
- ✓ Engine Degreaser, Brake Fluid
- ✓ Gasoline, Hydraulic Oil, Brake Fluid, etc.
- ✓ Poisons, Insecticides, Weed Killers, Lawn Chemicals Pesticides, Moth Balls.
- ✓ Photography Chemicals, Chemistry Sets
- ✓ Swimming Pool Chemicals
- ✓ Driveway Sealers (Oil Base only),
- ✓ Old Fire Extinguishers (Carbon Tetrachloride only)

WHAT NOT TO BRING:

- ✓ **Asbestos:** Call ME Dept of Environmental Protection at 1-800-452-1942.
- ✓ **Commercial or Industrial Waste:** Call ME Dept. of Environmental Protection at 1-800-452-1942 or EPI at 1-877-846-0447
- ✓ **Infectious & Biological Waste:** Call your local Hospital for instruction on how to dispose.
- ✓ **Reactive Products/Explosives:** This includes fireworks & no ammunitions.

These items can be recycled all year at Mid-Coast Solid Waste

Latex Paint ♦ Fluorescent Lights ♦ Car/Motorcycle Batteries ♦ ♦ Tires ♦ Rechargeable Batteries, PCB Ballasts ♦ CFL Bulbs ♦ Mercury Thermometers & Thermostats ♦ TV's and Computers ♦ Sharps (properly disposed of personal use only)

***COST PER UNIT:**

There is a \$10 fee for every unit. **Cash or Check ONLY.**

How much is a unit?

A unit is 5 gallons or 20 pounds of hazardous waste.

For Example: 1 unit could be a 5 gallon bucket of rubber cement or a collection of smaller containers of chemicals, such as a gallon of paint thinner, a small bag of dry pesticide and a few old aerosol cans.
