He’s building content on his own time and asking Pathways to add something about bicycle and pedestrian facilities, hikes, nice rides, etc. This would be similar content to the bike map that Maine Sport has plus the Parks and Rec map of parks in Camden. Still lacking is a similar map for Rockport Parks.
