CALL MEETING TO ORDER

- a. Dr. Turi opened the meeting at 5:26 p.m.

1. DISCUSSION OF HARBOR PARK LIGHTING

- a. Mr. Najpauer provided hard copies of lights and poles for the harbor project. He then delivered an overview of the three (3) lighting options and pole choices.
- b. The purpose of the grant is to provide lighting for recreational boaters and increase visits to Harbor Park and Rockport. The Grant will pay for a percentage of four (4) marine power pedestals for the floats, conduit, 12 light poles in the Park and all underground power.
- c. Lights will operate with a photo cell. Most of the light will be directed downwards with very little light showing above the fixture. With this type of lighting, a person's outline can be seen ten to twenty yards away although facial features are not clear. The power pedestals have outlets on have outlets on two (2) sides, are "very efficient" and have an expected life span of 10 years.
- d. Many of the 10' poles will be equipped with a 20 amp outlet for event use. All outlets will have weather tight locking outlet covers. There will be two (2) lighting circuits although only one (1) circuit may be used during winter months. Four (4) lights along the seawall and two (2) lights on the approach to the pier will be installed. Lights will not be located on the pier at this time. Two (2) trenches will be dug along the sea wall for the conduit. The trenches should be in place by July 1st although the fixtures may not be installed.
- e. Members from the Harbor Committee and Parks Committee chose the "F5J" pole with the "Utility" light fixture in black.

2. NEXT MEETING

- a. The next regular Harbor Committee meeting will held on May 22, 2014.

3. ADJOURNMENT

- a. The meeting adjourned at 6:50 p.m.
